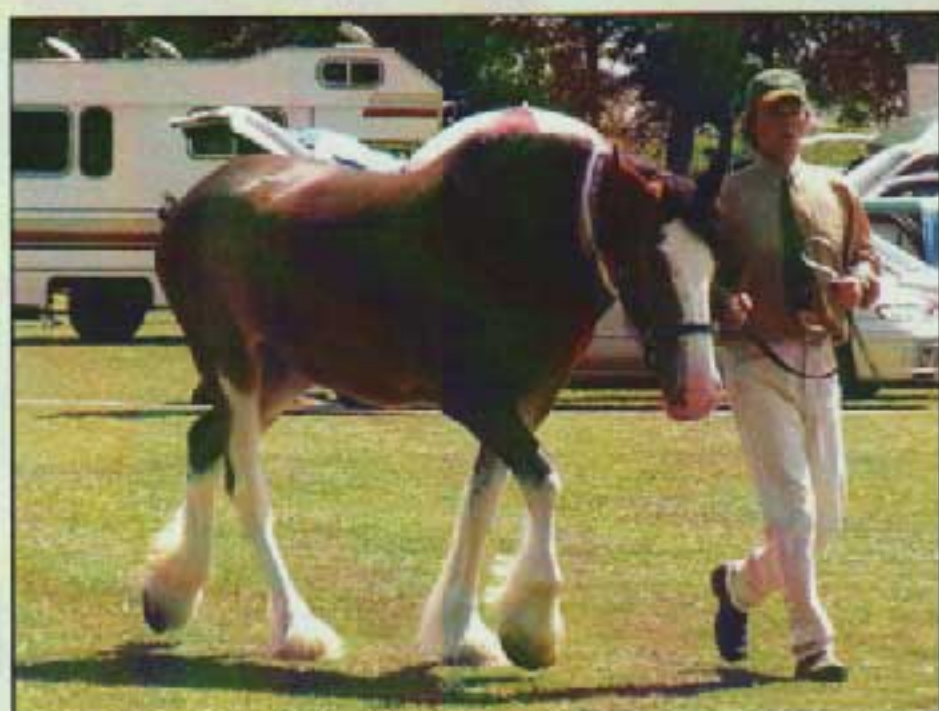

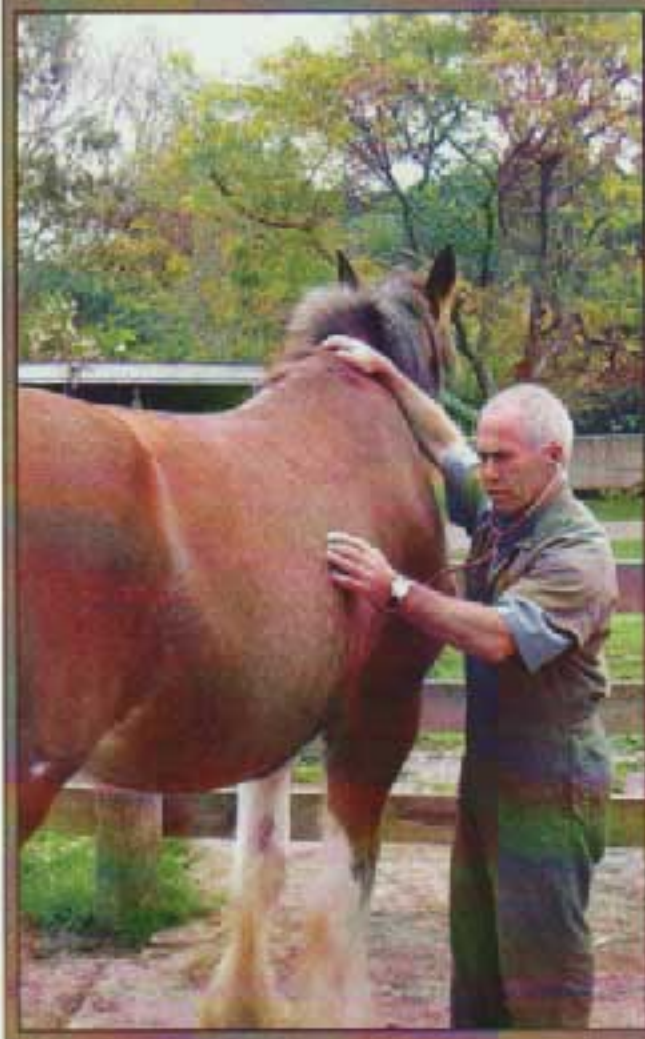
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HORSE OF THE YEAR 2007

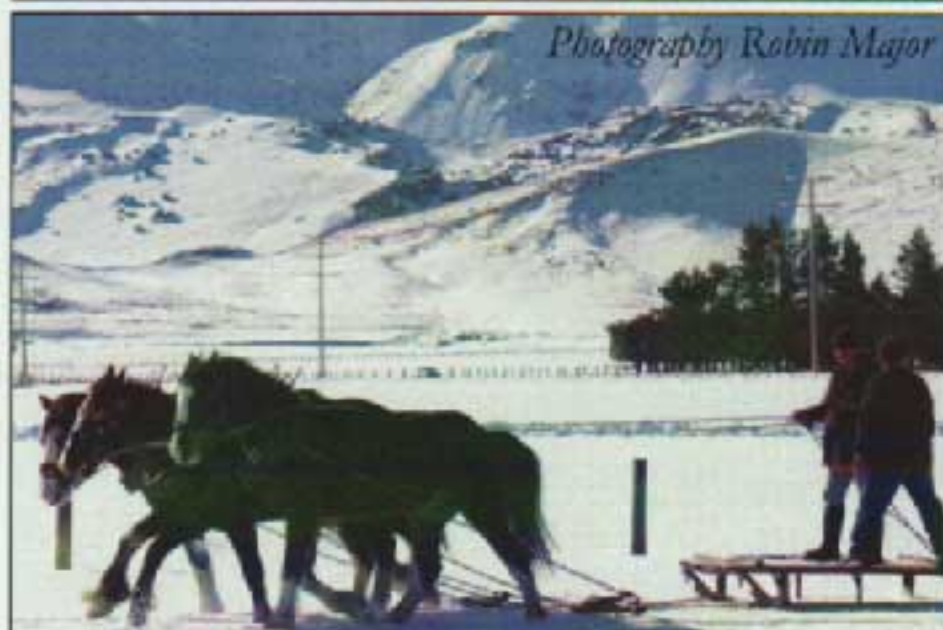
BITTEN BY THE HEAVY HORSE BUG

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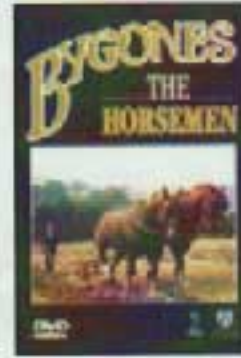

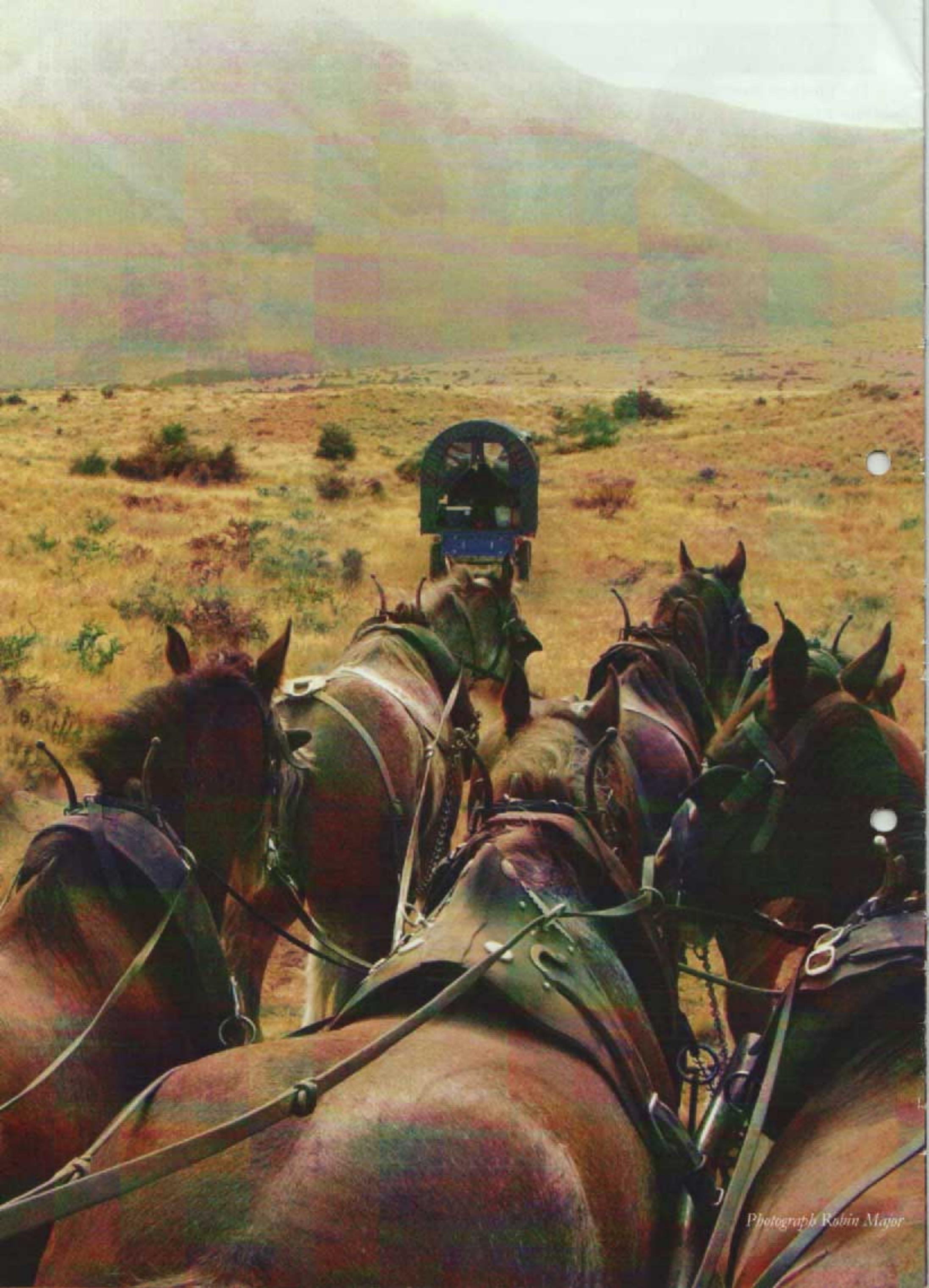
