

How to make an adjustable white rope show halter without any knots.

Materials: 3m Cotton Halter Cord (available from Donaghys NZ)

3 25x4mm stainless steel rings (available from Anzor NZ)

Method:

1. Fasten first ring onto one end of rope/cord by simply distending the centre of the rope and tucking about 8cm of the end back down inside it. Tension will lock it into place.
2. Slide the two remaining rings down the rope from the other end so they are roughly 30 cm from the "end" ring.
3. Hold the two rings in place and with loose end of rope reverse direction and go back through first ring only.
4. With loose end go back through "end" ring, leaving a generous loop
5. Thread the loose end back through the 3rd ring, leaving a loop.
6. Finish off loose end by tucking tail back into its centre
7. Adjust the nose, poll and chin piece to fit your horse.
